## HIGHLAND MALTS

25ML GLASS

### **ABERFELDY 16YR OLD**

£8.00

A well-rounded and mellow malt with a nose of raisins and cinnamon at first, before moving onto butterscotch, caramel and sliced apple. The palate is more apple at first, soon joined by clementine segments and honey on toast.

### **BALBLAIR 2002**

£8.50

The nose is sweet, with sponge cake, vanilla and cut grass. The palate is quite light; there is a delicious toffee sweetness, some fruity oak and buttery hints.

### **BLAIR ATHOLL 12YR OLD**

£6.50

Good body with lots of nuttiness, citrus zest and spice on the nose. The palate is packed with exotic fruit and spicy pepper with smoky hints and good length.

### **CLYNELISH 14YR OLD**

£5.50

A pleasant, floral aroma with a lush creamy mouth-feel; fruity and long lasting with a soft, smooth palate.

### **DALMORE 15YR OLD**

£7.50

This has a rich nose of orange and fruitcake with light floral notes, turning chocolatey and lightly spicy.

### **DEANSTON 18YR OLD**

£10.00

Incredibly smooth and rich with honey and vanilla on the nose, leading to a palate of shortbread, oak and ginger

### **DALWHINNIE 15YR OLD**

£6.00

From the highest distillery in Scotland (some say) at Drumochter Pass. Pale straw with a little peat and malt on the nose and palate. A lovely, savoury malt.

### **EDRADOUR 10YR OLD**

£5.50

From Scotland's smallest distillery. The flavour is complex, with some spice, minty freshness and a buttery aftertaste.

### **GLENMORANGIE QUINTA RUBAN 12YR OLD**

£6.00

A little oaky with notes of port. The palate is sweet, thick and almost chewy with red fruits and brown sugar.

**GLENMORANGIE 18YR OLD**

Creamy honey, grapefruit, exotic spice and berries fill the nose. The palate is packed with refreshing citrus, lychee, and creamy honey with a oaky, fruity finish.

**GLENTURRET 10YR OLD**

The lightest and most refreshing of the Glenturret malts. Richgold in colour with nutty, toasty aromas. The palate is rich and fruity with well-balanced oak tannins and hints of earthiness.

**GLENGOYNE 21YR OLD**

A big oaky malt from the outskirts of Glasgow. Red berries and oak on the nose. The palate follows through with cider, oak, cinnamon and allspice.

**OBAN 14YR OLD**

Amber in colour and a hit of the seaside. Flavour begins sweetish and ends dry with some peat smoke – unusual in a Highland.

**OLD PULTENEY 12YR OLD**

The nose is crisp and clean with great balance, revealing notes of fresh herbs. The palate is medium in body with nuts, sultana, toffee, spices and oak touches.

**TOMATIN 12YR OLD**

Delicately spicy on the nose, with fresh aniseed and sandalwood aromas. The palate is sweet biscuit with a touch of pistachio.

**TULLIBARDINE 1993 CONNOISSEURS CHOICE**

The nose is quite subtle and light, with notes of apple blossom and oats. The palate is warm with notes of white pepper and cloves. The oak is soft and chewy and develops with a touch of caramel on the finish.

25ML GLASS

**ARRAN 14YR OLD**

Stone fruits and vanilla on the nose and a palate with a full finish of citrus, vanilla and oak notes and just a little saltiness.

**ARDBEG**

Full-on peat aromas with this malt. Smooth and smoky with a little medicinal bite.

£5.50

**BOWMORE 25YR OLD**

This has a beautiful mixed nose of oak, peat smoke, salt and dark fruits. The palate is balanced with smokiness, cocoa, oak and a creamy nuttiness. The finish has a little prune to it.

**BRUICHLADDICH 10YR OLD**

Rich and creamy with lemon and honey on the nose, enhanced with oak touches. The palate is warm and oaky with sultana hints and a long-lasting finish.

**BUNNAHABHAIN 18YR OLD**

The nose here is leathery, salty and sweet. The palate and finish rides a wave of wood and chestnuts into salty and sherry sweetness with a hint of spice.

**CAOL ILA 12YR OLD**

Pale gold with a slightly greenish tinge. Quite light, with a malty biscuit and heather nose. Good body and a chocolatey, smooth finish.

**HIGHLAND PARK 12YR OLD**

Mid gold in colour; a delicate balance between sweet and dry on the palate, followed by a slightly honeyed mouthfeel and that characteristic smoky finish.

**HIGHLAND PARK 18YR OLD**

A profusion of ripe floral notes and fresh blossom and honeyed exotic fruits. The palate is creamy and full with powerful fruit flavours, followed by notes of toffee, with thick Black Forest honey and a touch more citrus.

<b>HIGHLAND PARK 25YR OLD</b>	£22.00
Aromas of cherries and toasted walnuts. The palate shows stewed fruit , vanilla and some peat with a hint of spiciness and a long, flavoursome finish. A fantastic malt with perfect balance.	
<b>HIGHLAND PARK 30YR OLD</b>	£39.95
After spending 30 years maturing, single malt has earned the right to be enjoyed very slowly, to have every sip savoured. An outstanding whisky, with rich chocolate and toffee notes and a gently smoky finish.	
<b>HIGHLAND PARK 21</b>	£18.50
Vaunted as the best expression of Highland Park by some, this malt has a beautifully sweet nose of toffee and balsamic. The finish offers the same sweetness, along with a little aniseed and spice.	
<b>ISLE OF JURA 10YR OLD</b>	£4.50
Light peat and oil on the nose. Relatively light with hints of sweet citrus and fruit ending on a dry, nutty finish.	
<b>ISLE OF JURA SUPERSTITION</b>	£5.80
Firm and positive yet mellow. Rich, sensual notes of honey and marzipan with lots of fruit on the finish.	
<b>LAGAVULIN 16YR OLD</b>	£7.50
The truest expression of an Islay malt. Salty, peaty with nutty hints and savoury smoke. The finish is long with oak, peat smoke, figs, dates and vanilla.	
<b>LAPHROAIG TRIPLE WOOD</b>	£6.50
First the distillers mature this in bourbon barrels, before transfer into quarter casks, and then a third maturation in European oak Oloroso sherry butts. Astonishing, with oodles of peat smoke and sweetness.	
<b>PORT ELLEN 1980 AMERICAN OAK</b>	£65.00
Magical! A nose of honeyed oak, grape and dried herbs. The palate has smoky fruit - salad notes with more honey, salt and pepper, marsh samphire and green apples, and a little leather on the finish.	

<b>SCAPA GLANSA</b>	£6.00
A smoked fruity nose leading to a palate of peach, creamy caramel toffee and vanilla, balanced perfectly with soft smoke.	
<b>SCAPA 16YR OLD</b>	£7.25
Light, un-peated and dry, with some floral and herbal notes and just a hint of orange.	
<b>TALISKER 10YR OLD</b>	£5.50
Mid gold with pungent, burnt-wood aromas. Full-bodied with a spicy, smoky and black pepper finish. Also known as ‘the lava of the Cuillins’.	
<b>TOBERMORY 10YR OLD</b>	£4.50
Light with a touch of nuttiness and toffee. An easy introduction to the island whiskies.	
<b>SPEYSIDE MALTS</b>	25ML GLASS
<b>ABERLOUR 10YR OLD</b>	£4.50
Rich in body with a generous finish. A tasty dram with aromas of vanilla, pine and a trace of peat.	
<b>ABERLOUR A'BUNDAH</b>	£7.00
Drawn from Spanish Oloroso Sherry butts and bottled at cask strength. A nose of mocha, gingerbread and raisins with a palate of chocolate, Christmas spices and walnut.	
<b>THE BALVENIE 12 YR (DOUBLE WOOD)</b>	£5.50
Deep amber in colour. Re-racked in Oloroso sherry casks to give a sherry-like nose with a nutty, malty finish.	
<b>BALVENIE 14 YR OLD CARIBBEAN CASK</b>	£7.00
A rich creamy toffee and tropical fruit aroma with a deep demerara sugar, orange and vanilla palate.	
<b>BENROMACH TRADITIONAL</b>	£5.50
A nose both nutty and smoky with a hint of pine, leading into a floral palate that is lightly buttery and spicy.	

<b>BENRIACH 20YR OLD</b>	£11.00
The nose is of malt and toffee, with a big oaky presence. The palate is juicy with honey and floral notes, leaving a long caramel and oak finish.	
<b>CARDHU 12YR OLD</b>	£5.50
The nose shows good body, decent sweetness and richness with streaks of smoke, apple peel and pears. The palate is smooth and rounded with gentle sweetness, soft peat and little whispers of smoke.	
<b>CRAIGELLACHIE 10YR OLD</b>	£5.80
A tasty expression of smooth malty flavours, enhanced with citrus notes and lovely floral hints.	
<b>CRAGGANMORE 12YR OLD</b>	£5.50
Cider apples, pine essence and toasty oak come through on the nose and palate. Fragrant, soft and gentle.	
<b>GLEN ELGIN 12YR OLD</b>	£5.50
Soft and malty with hints of honey, lightly salted butter and toasted sultanas. The finish has good length, with touches of barley and toasted oats.	
<b>GLENFARCLAS 21YR OLD</b>	£13.50
A nose of orange, apple and sherry that leads into a long, incredibly smooth and barley-rich finish.	
<b>GLENFIDDICH IPA CASK FINISH</b>	£6.50
Part of Glenfiddich's Experimental Series, this single malt was finished for three months in casks which previously held IPA. The palate is vibrant, with a zesty citrus note followed by creamy vanilla and a hint of fresh hops.	
<b>GLENFIDDICH 15YR OLD</b>	£9.00
The nose shows sherry and citrus with smoky oak hints, which follow through to the palate; a slight spiciness adds to the flavours followed by a fruitcake and spice finish.	

<b>GLENFIDDICH 18YR OLD</b>	£12.00
Loads of fruit on the nose, with zesty grapefruit, baked toffee apples and cinnamon. The palate has a lovely balanced freshness with candied fruit, rich apricot, toffee and sherry hints.	
<b>GLENLIVET 15YR OLD</b>	£6.00
With a nose of madeira, fudge and apple crumble. The finish is dry and peppery with a hint of citrus and clove.	
<b>GLENLOSSIE 10YR OLD</b>	£6.50
The nose is full of cereal with notes of malt and wood shavings. The palate has good body with a decent sweetness and plenty of fruit, with barley sugar and peppery oak.	
<b>GLENROTHES 1995</b>	£12.00
A beautifully golden malt with a chocolatey, honeycomb nose. The palate is wonderfully rich and creamy with citrus and soft oak hints.	
<b>GLENROTHES SELECT RESERVE</b>	£5.50
Oak and vanilla aromas with plummy hints. The palate is fruity with vanilla and orange-zest and a long, slightly spicy finish.	
<b>INCHGOWER 14YR OLD</b>	£6.50
A rich caramel, toffee nose with a slight nuttiness that comes through in the rich and smooth palate, developing into a drier, spicy and slightly salty taste.	
<b>KNOCKANDO 12 YR OLD</b>	£5.00
Pale gold with leafy and toffee notes. The mouthfeel is wonderfully smooth and complex with balanced dryness.	
<b>LINKWOOD 12YR OLD</b>	£6.00
A nose that's is grassy, herbaceous and nutty. The palate shows almonds, honey and pine with a long finish.	

**MACALLAN RARE CASK** £20.00

Lemon citrus nose with lingering floral and light oak notes. The palate shows citrus and boiled sweets along with hints of ginger and cinnamon, while soft oak tones reveal toasted apples.

**MORTLACH RARE OLD MALT** £8.00

Baked apple and crushed nuts with leafy notes on the nose. The palate is rich and full with spicy notes of cinnamon and oak, culminating in vanilla, raisin and biscuity notes paired with dark jammy touches.

**SINGLETON OF DUFFTOWN 12YR OLD** £5.50

Nutty and malty with a fruity edge. Great if you are new to the whisky adventure.

**STRATHISLA 12YR OLD** £4.50

Soft oak on the nose with hints of candied peel. The palate has a malty core with sultanas and cinnamon touches followed by a long, fruity finish.

**TAMDHU 10YR OLD** £6.95

Sherry-cask matured and full of the sweet, rich and creamy flavours you'd expect from a great malt.

**LOWLAND MALTS** 25ML GLASS

**AUCHENTOSHAN 12YR OLD** £5.50

Grassy, green and meadow-like. Triple distilled for a softer flavour, it has cereal notes and a dry, lemony finish

**BLADNOCH 1987** £13.00

The nose is aromatic and herbaceous. Cereal notes develop with malty sweet barley, spiciness and notes of dry wood. The palate is sweet with spice and soft oak, and a long, smooth finish.

**GLENKINCHIE 12YR OLD** £5.00

Almost the colour of white wine, this has a light, fragrant nose with vanilla and meadow-fresh notes. Slightly sweet start with fresh fruit and ginger on the finish.

**CAMPBELTOWN MALTS** 25ML GLASS

**HAZELBURN 10YR OLD** £5.50

A nose of honey, vanilla, pears and toffee apples. Fruity and a little chocolatey on the palate with a sweet finish.

**LONGROW 18YR OLD** £11.00

The nose here is smoky, earthy with a hint of apple peel, while the palate is peaty, spicy, orange zest and a little sweet.

**SPRINGBANK 18YR OLD** £11.00

Bananas, honey and glacé cherries jump out on the nose. The palate is big and rich with a fruity, smoky, salty and chocolatey finish.
