## COGNAC

---

Named after the town of Cognac in France, where it is produced, Cognac is a variety of brandy pot-distilled from the juice of the Trebbiano grape and aged for a minimum of two years – sometimes up to 100. In both cases, the letters VS mean the brandy has been aged for two years; VSOP indicates three; and XO, six.

## VODKA

---

Taking its name from the Slavic word for water ('voda'), vodka – or variants of it – emerged across the countries of northern Europe and Scandinavia (the so-called 'vodka belt') in the 1400s, likely originating in Poland.

Blending ethanol distilled from grains or potatoes with water, it is colourless and largely flavourless – which is probably why humanity has found no better mixer drink in the last 600 years.
